Lord willing, I will continue to do what Billy and I was most heavily involved in over the past two years; ministering internationally, partnering with Sammy Tippit Ministries. In August, I will be ministering in Brasilia, which is the political capital of Brazil, and then in November, in war-torn Angola, Africa.
